AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to providing a waiver from the driving skills test for a driver's license for active duty and recently discharged military personnel

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 502 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new paragraph (i) to read as follows:
- 3 (I) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE 4 WAIVER OF ANY TEST REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH 5 (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION FOR ANY PERSON WHO HAS DEMONSTRATED THE DRIVING 6 SKILLS NECESSARY TO PASS SUCH TEST THROUGH HIS OR HER SERVICE IN THE 7 UNITED STATES ARMY, NAVY, AIR FORCE, MARINES, COAST GUARD, AND/OR 8 RESERVES THEREOF, AND/OR THE ARMY NATIONAL GUARD, AIR NATIONAL GUARD, 9 NEW YORK GUARD AND/OR THE NEW YORK NAVAL MILITIA, AND WHO IS CURRENTLY
- 10 IN SERVICE OR WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER HONORABLE
- 11 CIRCUMSTANCES FROM SUCH SERVICE LESS THAN ONE YEAR PRIOR TO HIS OR HER
- 12 REQUEST FOR SUCH A WAIVER.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
