AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the deferral of vacation days for certain members of the retirement system

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 89 of the retirement and social security law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1 to read as follows:

L. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ANY GENERAL, LAW, CODE, RESOLUTION OR CHARTER TO THE CONTRARY, MEMBERS OF THE 5 UNIFORMED FORCE OF THE NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION OPTION OF POSTPONING THE USE OF UP TO FIVE VACATION DAYS AFFORDED THE PER YEAR AND TAKING A MONETARY PAYMENT IN LIEU THEREOF ON THE8 RETIREMENT AT THE PAY RATE APPLICABLE TO SUCH MEMBER ON THE DATE OF SUCH 9 RETIREMENT. SUCH MONETARY PAYMENT SHALL NOT BE UTILIZED IN THE 10 DETERMINATION OF FINAL AVERAGE SALARY FOR ANY SUCH MEMBER WHO SO ELECTS POSTPONE VACATION DAYS PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION. ANY SUCH MEMBER 11

- WISHING TO POSTPONE THE USE OF VACATION DAYS PURSUANT TO THIS 12 SUBDIVI-13 SHALL ELECT SUCH POSTPONEMENT ON AN ANNUAL BASIS BY CERTIFYING TO
- THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL OF HIS OR HER RESPECTIVE EMPLOYER OF 14
- 15 INTENTION TO DO SO IN SUCH MANNER AND FORM AS THE RESPECTIVE DIREC-
- 16 TOR SHALL SO REQUIRE.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
