AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to Buffalo city school district petitions for nomination of school board members

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraphs f and g of subdivision 10 of section 2553 of the
2 education law, as added by chapter 242 of the laws of 1974, are amended
3 to read as follows:
4 f. Petitions for the nomination of members of such school board shall
5 be on white paper containing the required signatures of qualified voters
6 of the city of Buffalo. The sheets of such petition shall be numbered
7 consecutively, beginning with number one, at the foot of each sheet.
8 Such a petition must set forth in every instance the correct date of
9 signing, the full name of the signer[,] AND his [present] OR HER resi-
10 dence[, the residence from which he was registered at the time of the
11 last preceding general election, if he was registered at that time, the
12 city school subdistrict of such residence at such time and the election
13 district thereof at such time. A signer need not himself fill in the
14 date, residence or residences, city school subdistrict or election
15 district. The election district of the signer to be filed in the peti-
16 tion shall be the election district in effect at the time of the last
17 preceding general election. If the residence from which the signer was
18 registered at the time of the last preceding general election is the
19 same as his present residence, the word "same" may be written, instead
20 of repeating the place of residence. If the signer was not registered at
21 the time of the last general election, he shall write "not registered at
22 that time."]. A SIGNER NEED ONLY PLACE HIS OR HER SIGNATURE UPON THE
23 PETITION, AND NEED NOT HIMSELF OR HERSELF FILL IN THE OTHER REQUIRED
24 INFORMATION.
25 g. Each sheet of such a petition shall be signed in ink and shall be
26 substantially in the following form:

20 The petition shall be authenticated by witnesses. Such statement shall
 21 be accepted for all purposes as the equivalent of an affidavit, and if
 22 false shall subject the witness to the same penalties as if he OR SHE
 23 had been duly sworn. The form of such statement shall be substantially
 24 as follows:

25 STATEMENT OF WITNESS

 27 fied voter of the state of New York, and now reside in the city, town or
