AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting the sale of electronic cigarettes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1399-aa of the public health law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 13 to read as follows:
3 13. "ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE" MEANS A BATTERY-OPERATED DEVICE THAT
4 CONTAINS CARTRIDGES FILLED WITH A COMBINATION OF NICOTINE, FLAVOR AND
5 CHEMICALS THAT ARE TURNED INTO VAPOR WHICH IS INHALED BY THE USER.
6 S 2. Section 1399-ll of the public health law, as added by chapter 518
7 of the laws of 2000, is redesignated section 1399-ll-1 and a new section
8 1399-ll-2 is added to read as follows:
9 S 1399-LL-2. SALE OF ELECTRONIC CIGARETTES PROHIBITED. NO PERSON SHALL
10 SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE ANY ELECTRONIC CIGARETTE.
11 S 3. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
12 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
