Introduced by M. of A. DINOWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law and the education law, in relation to prohibiting smoking within 100 feet of the entrances or exits of any public or private educational institutions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 1399-o of the public health law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
3 3. SMOKING SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED AND NO PERSON SHALL SMOKE WITHIN ONE
4 HUNDRED FEET OF THE ENTRANCES, EXITS OR OUTDOOR AREAS OF ANY PUBLIC OR
5 PRIVATE ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOLS.
6 S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 409 of the education law, as amended by
7 chapter 13 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:
8 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, rule or regulation,
9 tobacco use shall not be permitted and no person shall use
10 tobacco on school grounds. "School grounds" means any building, structure
11 and surrounding outdoor grounds, INCLUDING ENTRANCES OR EXITS, contained
12 within a public or private pre-school, nursery school, elementary or
13 secondary school's legally defined property boundaries as registered in a
14 county clerk's office.
15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
