Introduced by M. of A. CLARK, CALHOUN, COLTON, TOBACCO, CONTE, GRAF, TITUS, FINCH, BARRETT, RA, BURLING, SWEENEY, McDONOUGH, THIELE, CUSICK, GUNTHER, GOODELL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the public health law and the penal law, in relation to controlled substances and to provide a defense for sale or administration of synthetic cannabinoids in certain circumstances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 3302 of the public health law, 1 as added by chapter 878 of the laws of 1972 and as renumbered by chapter 2 3 537 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read as follows: 4

4. "Concentrated Cannabis" means

5 [(a)] the separated resin, whether crude or purified, obtained from a 6 plant of the genus Cannabis[; or

a material, preparation, mixture, compound or other substance 7 (b) which contains more than two and one-half percent by weight of delta-9 8 tetrahydrocannabinol, or its isomer, delta-8 dibenzopyran numbering 9 system, or delta-1 tetrahydrocannabinol or its isomer, delta 1 (6) mono-10 11 terpene numbering system].

S 2. Subdivisions 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39 and 40 of section 3302 of 12 the public health law are renumbered subdivisions 34, 35, 36, 37, 13 38, 39, 40 and 41 and a new subdivision 33 is added to read as follows: 14

15 "SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID" MEANS ANY MATERIAL, COMPOUND, MIXTURE OR 33. 16 PREPARATION CONTAINING ANY QUANTITY OF:

(A) CP 47,497 AND HOMOLOGUES: 2-5-(2-METHYLOCTAN-2-YL)PHENOL;

(B) HU-210;

THE DATABASE SHALL BE PUBLISHED ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE SO THAT CONSUMERS, RETAILERS, AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES CAN 16 ACCESS INFORMATION INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: 17 (A) A LIST OF COMPOUNDS KNOWN TO BELONG TO THE CLASSES 18 OF CHEMICALS 19 LISTED ABOVE, AND THEIR TRADE NAMES; 20 A PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCTS KNOWN CONTAIN (B) TΟ SUCH 21 COMPOUNDS, AND THEIR EFFECTS; AND 22 (C) A LIST OF THE BRAND NAMES KNOWN ТΟ OF PRODUCTS CONTAIN SUCH 23 COMPOUNDS, AND IMAGES OF THEIR PACKAGING. 24 THE WEBSITE SHALL INCLUDE A STATEMENT INDICATING THAT SUCH INFORMATION 25 BEING PROVIDED AS A RESOURCE FOR CONSUMERS, RETAILERS, AND LAW IS 26 ENFORCEMENT; AND, DUE TO THE NATURE OF THE ILLEGAL DRUG TRADE, SUCH 27 INFORMATION MAY NOT BE COMPREHENSIVE. NEITHER THE DEPARTMENT NOR THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY 28 ECONOMIC 29 HARM, PERSONAL INJURY, OR DEATH THAT MAY RESULT FROM INFORMATION INCLUDED IN, OR OMITTED FROM, THE DATABASE. 30 S 5. Subdivisions 5, 6 and 10 of section 220.00 of the penal law, subdivision 5 as amended by chapter 537 of the laws of 1998, subdivision 31 32 as amended by chapter 1051 of the laws of 1973 and subdivision 10 as 33 6 amended by chapter 664 of the laws of 1985, are amended to read as 34 35 follows: 36 5. "Controlled substance" means any substance listed in schedule I, II, III, IV or V of section thirty-three hundred six of the public 37 38 health law other than marihuana, but including concentrated cannabis as defined in [paragraph (a) of] subdivision four, AND SYNTHETIC CANNABI-39 40 NOID AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION THIRTY-THREE, of section thirty-three hundred two of such law. 41 6. 1 S 7. Subdivision 10 of section 220.09 of the penal law, as amended by 2 chapter 537 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read as follows:

16 S 9. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 220.79 to read 17 as follows:

18 S 220.79 DEFENSE FOR SALE OR ADMINISTRATION OF SAMPLES OF SYNTHETIC 19 CANNABINOID.

20 IT SHALL BE A DEFENSE THAT ANY PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP, 21 ASSOCIATION, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY OR OTHER ENTITY THAT SOLD, 22 OFFERED FOR SALE OR GAVE AWAY AS EITHER A RETAIL OR WHOLESALE PROMOTION 23 ANY PRODUCT WHICH CONTAINS A SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID, DID NOT HAVE KNOW-THAT IT WAS A PRODUCT CONTAINING A SYNTHETIC CANNABINOID, IF SUCH 24 LEDGE 25 KNOWLEDGE WAS NOT REASONABLY DISCOVERABLE.

26 S 10. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 27 have become a law; provided, however, that the commissioner of health and the division of criminal justice services shall immediately take the 28 29 actions necessary to ensure that the database created by subdivision 7 section 3308 of the public health law, as added by section four of 30 of this act is established and maintained in accordance with such subdivi-31 32 sion, and provided further, that, notwithstanding the provisions of any 33 law to the contrary, for ninety days after this act shall have become law, section 220.03, 220.06, 220.09, 220.16, 220.18, 220.21, 221.05, 221.10, 221.15, 221.20, 221.25 or 221.30 of the penal law shall not be 34 35 enforced with regard to the possession of synthetic cannabinoids, as 36 defined in section 3302 of the public health law. 37
