AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring that a center for palliative care be established in every borough of New York city

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 2807-n of the public health law, as added by section 63-f of part C of chapter 58 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:
- Centers for palliative care excellence. The commissioner shall 5 designate organizations licensed pursuant to this article and article forty of this chapter, upon successful application, as centers for palliative care excellence. Such designations shall be pursuant to an 8 application as designed by the department, and based on service, staff-9 ing and other criteria as developed by the council. Such centers of 10 excellence shall provide specialized palliative care, treatment, education and related services. A CENTER OF PALLIATIVE CARE EXCELLENCE 11 ESTABLISHED IN EACH OF THE FIVE BOROUGHS OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK. 12 Designation as a center for palliative care excellence shall not entitle
- 13 Designation as a center for palliative care excellence shall not entitle 14 a center to enhanced reimbursement, but may be utilized in outreach and
- 15 other promotional activities.
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
