AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to permitting certain motor vehicles on a certain segment of public roads

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 16 of section 385 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new paragraph (v) to read as follows:

- (V) WITHIN A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 1.65 MILES FROM EXIT NUMBER THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY, SUCH DISTANCE TO BE MEASURED IN A SOUTH-EASTERLY DIRECTION FROM THE POINT WHERE STATE ROUTE 32 INTERSECTS THE SOUTHBOUND ACCESS RAMP LEADING TO THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY, OVER A ROUTE EXTENDING IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION ON STATE ROUTE 32, AND THEN EASTERLY ALONG US ROUTE 9W FOR A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.14 MILES, TO WASHINGTON AVENUE BETWEEN US ROUTE 9W AND RUSSELL STREET, A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.13 MILES, AND WEST ON RUSSELL STREET BETWEEN WASHING-TON AVENUE AND THE COTERMINOUS SEGMENT OF US ROUTE 9W AND STATE ROUTE
- 32, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS PARTITION STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF SAUGERTIES, A 12
- DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.14 MILES. 13
