AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to designating certain persons appointed by a county sheriff's office as peace officers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by  
2     adding a new subdivision 83 to read as follows:  
3     83. PERSONS APPOINTED BY A COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, OUTSIDE OF NEW  
4     YORK CITY, WHEN ACTING PURSUANT TO THEIR SPECIAL DUTIES SERVING AS  
5     UNIFORMED DEPUTIES WORKING IN A SPECIALIZED FUNCTION INCLUDING BUT NOT  
6     LIMITED TO MOUNTED PATROL, MARINE PATROL, SNOWMOBILE PATROL, ATV PATROL,  
7     FORENSIC, SCIENTIFIC, OR AVIATION. SUCH PERSONS MUST HAVE SUCCESSFULLY  
8     COMPLETED PEACE OFFICER TRAINING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2.30 OF THIS ARTI-  
9     CLE. NOTHING IN THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED TO AUTHORIZE SUCH OFFI-  
10    CER OR AGENT TO CARRY, POSSESS, REPAIR, OR DISPOSE OF A FIREARM UNLESS  
11    THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE THEREFOR HAS BEEN ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION  
12    400.00 OF THE PENAL LAW.  
13    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
