AN ACT to amend the navigation law, in relation to the regulation of the manner of construction and location of boathouses, moorings and docks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 46-a of the navigation law, as amended by chapter 278 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

- 3 The local legislative body of the village of Sodus Point and the (2) 5 town of Huron in the county of Wayne, the villages of Croton-on-Hudson 6 and Mamaroneck and the town of Cortlandt in the county of Westchester, 7 the town of Stony Point in the county of Rockland, the town of Island in the county of Erie, the towns of Conesus, Geneseo, Groveland and Livonia in the county of Livingston, the towns of Irondequoit, Webster, and Penfield in the county of Monroe, the village of Greenwood 9 10 11 Lake and the town of Warwick in the county of Orange, the town of ton in the county of Orleans, the village of Sackets Harbor in the coun-12 of Jefferson, and the villages of Union Springs, Aurora and Cayuga 13 and the towns of Genoa and Ledyard in the county of Cayuga, the [town] 14 TOWNS of Ithaca AND ULYSSES in the county of Tompkins, the city of King-15 16 ston and the village of Saugerties in the county of Ulster and the town of Porter in the county of Niagara, and the village of North Haven in 17 the county of Suffolk may adopt, amend and enforce local laws, rules and 18 19 regulations not inconsistent with the laws of this state or the United 20 States, with respect to the restriction and regulation of the manner of 21 construction and location of boathouses, moorings and docks in any 22 waters within or bounding the respective municipality to a distance of fifteen hundred feet from the shoreline. 23
