AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to establishing an opioid addiction treatment and hospital diversion demonstration program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 3309-b to read as follows:
- S 3309-B. OPIOID ADDICTION TREATMENT AND HOSPITAL DIVERSION DEMON-STRATION PROGRAM. 1. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, SHALL, WITHIN 5 THE AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED THEREFOR, ESTABLISH AN OPIOID ADDICTION TREATMENT AND HOSPITAL DIVERSION DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. THIS PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE A 8 NEW MODEL OF DETOXIFICATION AND TRANSITIONAL SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS 9 SEEKING TO RECOVER FROM OPIOID ADDICTION, THEREBY REDUCING RELIANCE EMERGENCY ROOM SERVICES. THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE TREATMENT OF 10 PRESCRIPTION PAIN MEDICATION ADDICTION ON AN OUTPATIENT 11 OR NON-MEDICAL SHORT-TERM STAY BASIS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH UP 12 RESIDENTIAL 13 TO SIX DEMONSTRATIONS THROUGHOUT THE STATE, AND AT MINIMUM A DEMON-ESTABLISHED IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS: WESTERN 14 STRATION SHALL BE 15 NEW YORK, CENTRAL NEW YORK, STATEN ISLAND, BROOKLYN AND LONG ISLAND.
- 2. NOT LATER THAN TWO YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS 16 COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE THE GOVERNOR, THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF 17 18 THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE CHAIR OF THE SENATE 19 ING COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND THE CHAIR OF THE ASSEMBLY HEALTH COMMITTEE 20 WITH A WRITTEN EVALUATION OF THE DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM. SUCH EVALUATION 21 THE OVERALL EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS TREATMENT MODEL AS IT SHALL ADDRESS RELATES TO PATIENTS, THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY, HEALTH CARE 22 PROVIDERS HEALTH CARE PAYORS, AND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE 23 EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PROGRAM IN PROVIDING ACCESS TO SERVICES, THE IMPACT 24 OF THESE SERVICES, THE ASSOCIATED COSTS SAVINGS, AND WHETHER THE EXPAN-
