AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to nominating and designating petitions and certificates

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 6-158 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 434 of the laws of 1984, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 2. A certificate of acceptance or declination of a designation shall 5 be filed not later than the fourth day after the last day to file such 6 designation, EXCEPT THAT A CANDIDATE WHO FILES SUCH A CERTIFICATE OF 7 ACCEPTANCE FOR AN OFFICE FOR WHICH THERE HAVE BEEN FILED CERTIFICATES OR 8 PETITIONS DESIGNATING MORE THAN ONE CANDIDATE FOR THE NOMINATION OF ANY 9 PARTY, MAY THEREAFTER FILE A CERTIFICATE OF DECLINATION NOT LATER THAN 10 THE SEVENTH DAY AFTER THE PRIMARY ELECTION.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
