AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to satisfaction of a security interest in a motor vehicle by a dealer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of section 2121 of the vehicle and traffic law is designated subdivision (a) and a new subdivision (b) is added to read as follows:

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A DEALER WHO RECEIVES A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE PURPOSES OF RESALE AND WHO ARRANGES FOR THE SATISFACTION OF ANY SECURITY INTEREST 5 IN SUCH AND FOR WHICH A RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST HAS NOT BEEN 7 ISSUED, MAY SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSIONER SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE 8 STRATE THAT SUCH SECURITY INTEREST HAS BEEN SATISFIED. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL, UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH EVIDENCE, A PROPER APPLICATION 9 AND THE 10 FEE PURSUANT TO SECTION TWENTY-ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE OF APPROPRIATE THIS ARTICLE, PROMPTLY ISSUE, WITHIN NO MORE THAN FIFTEEN BUSINESS 11 12 RECEIPT BYTHE DEPARTMENT OF ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION AND FEES, OF EITHER A DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE WITHOUT SUCH LIEN INCLUDED THEREON, OR A 13 CERTIFICATE WITHOUT SUCH LIEN INCLUDED THEREON. EVIDENCE THAT A SECURITY 14 15 INTEREST HAS BEEN SATISFIED SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: (I) EVIDENCE THAT AN INTRABANK TRANSFER OF FUNDS HAS 16 BEEN MADE; 17 EVIDENCE THAT A COPY OF A CERTIFIED CHECK HAS BEEN DELIVERED; OR (III) EVIDENCE THAT AN UNCERTIFIED CHECK OR DRAFT ISSUED BY A DEALER 18 DO BUSINESS IN THIS STATE HAS BEEN DELIVERED. SUCH EVIDENCE SHALL BE 19 ACCEPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER AS SUFFICIENT. ANY EVIDENCE 20 SUBMITTED 21 COMMISSIONER PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION MAY BE SUBMITTED IN ELEC-IN ADDITION TO THE PENALTIES IMPOSED BY SECTION TWENTY-ONE HUNDRED THIRTY OF THIS ARTICLE, ANY DEALER WHO ALTERS OR FORGES EVIDENCE 23

OF PAYMENT SHALL BE LIABLE TO ANY PARTY FOR ANY DAMAGES RESULTING FROM

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ISSUANCE OF A NEW CERTIFICATE BY THE COMMISSIONER, PLUS ATTORNEY'S

- FEES AND COSTS INCURRED IN RECOVERING SUCH DAMAGES, PROVIDED HOWEVER NO
- SUBSEQUENT PURCHASER OF A VEHICLE WHERE THE SECURITY INTEREST WAS REMOVED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION
- SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY ERRORS IN THE REMOVAL OF SUCH SECURITY INTEREST, AND ANY DEALER WHO SO APPLIED FOR THE REMOVAL OF SUCH SECURITY INTEREST
- 7 SUCH VEHICLE SHALL INDEMNIFY ANY SUCH PURCHASER. THE COMMISSIONER IS
- 8 AUTHORIZED TO ADOPT AND ENFORCE REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS NECES-
- SARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION. 9
