AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to enacting the "public internet access safety act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as
2 the "public internet access safety act".
3 S 2. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 843-a to

5 S 843-A. PUBLIC LIBRARY HOMEPAGE ON THE INTERNET; WARNING. NOTWITH-
6 STANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, RULE OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY,
7 THE DIVISION SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN AN INTERNET WEBSITE PROVIDING
8 INFORMATION TO MINORS ON THE POTENTIAL DANGERS TO MINORS USING THE
9 INTERNET CONCERNING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SEXUAL PREDATORS, SAFE BLOG-
10 GING, ON-LINE BULLYING, SOCIAL NETWORKING SAFETY, AND SUCH OTHER INTER-
11 NET SAFETY INFORMATION AS THE DIVISION DEEMS APPROPRIATE, AND EVERY
12 PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM SHALL MAKE THE HOMEPAGE OF THIS WEBSITE THE HOME-
13 PAGE OF ITS WEBSITE PROVIDING INTERNET ACCESS TO MINORS IN A PUBLIC
14 LIBRARY.
15 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
