AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to genetically modified organisms

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new section 9-107 to read as follows:
- S 9-107. GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS;
- AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE. ANY PARTY WHO IS SUED FOR DAMAGES FOR VIOLATION OF
- A PATENT, TRADEMARK, OR OTHER INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS ON THE GROUND
- THAT THE PARTY POSSESSED OR USED SEEDS OR PLANTS THAT CONTAINED GENET-7 ICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS WITHOUT ENTERING
- 8 INTO AN AGREEMENT OR PAYING FEES TO THE MANUFACTURER OR
- 9 DISTRIBUTOR OF SUCH GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED
- ORGANISMS SHALL HAVE AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE AGAINST ANY LIABILITY IF THE 10
- PARTY SHALL SHOW THAT HE OR SHE DID NOT KNOWINGLY AND INTENTIONALLY 11
- THE GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS 12
- 13 INTO HIS OR HER PLANTS OR SEEDS OR ONTO HIS OR HER PROPERTY AND HE
- SHE DID NOT KNOWINGLY GAIN FROM THE DISTINCTIVE TRAITS DUE TO GENETIC 14
- MODIFICATION OR GENETIC ENGINEERING. 15
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
