AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the sale of over-the-counter drugs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The article heading of article 38-A of the general business  
2 law, as added by chapter 697 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as  
3 follows:

6 AND LABEL OBSTRUCTED OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS  
7 S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 820 of the general business law, as  
8 added by chapter 697 of the laws of 1986, is amended to read as follows:  
9 2. to knowingly alter, mutilate, destroy, obliterate or remove by  
10 means of a price sticker or otherwise the whole or any part of [the  
11 expiration date displayed on] the label [or packaging], INCLUDING WHERE  
12 APPLICABLE THE EXPIRATION DATE DISPLAYED THEREON, of any over-the-coun-  
13 ter drug OR COSMETIC. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE TERM "LABEL"  
14 SHALL MEAN THE LABEL REQUIRED BY THE STATUTES APPLICABLE TO AND REGU-  
15 LATIONS ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION.  
S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
