AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to creating and distributing a drug guide for senior consumers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The elder law is amended by adding a new section 224 to 2 read as follows:
- S 224. SENIOR DRUG GUIDE. THE DIRECTOR, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STATE 4 BOARD OF PHARMACY, AND AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE CONSUMER 5 PROTECTION BOARD, SHALL WITHIN AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION 6 THEREFOR PREPARE AND PUBLISH A GUIDE EXPLAINING THE PURPOSE, FUNCTION,
- 7 AND COMMON DRUG INTERACTIONS OF DRUGS COMMONLY USED BY PERSONS OVER THE
- 8 AGE OF SIXTY-TWO. THE DIRECTOR SHALL TAKE SUCH ACTIONS AS SHALL BE 9 NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO MAKE SUCH GUIDE AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS
- 10 UPON REQUEST AND WITHOUT CHARGE THROUGH DESIGNATED AGENCIES, AS SUCH
- 11 TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN OF THIS TITLE, EXCEPT
- 12 THAT REQUESTS FOR MORE THAN TEN COPIES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A NOMINAL
- 13 CHARGE TO COVER THE COST OF REPRODUCTION AND HANDLING.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 15 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
