AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to check cashing policies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The banking law is amended by adding a new section 9-v to
2 read as follows:
3 S 9-V. CASHING OF CERTAIN CHECKS. 1. NO BANKING INSTITUTION AS SUCH
4 TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION NINE-F OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL, REFUSE TO CASH
5 CHECKS, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS OR LESS, DRAWN ON ACCOUNTS
6 IN SUCH INSTITUTION OR A BRANCH AS LONG AS THERE ARE SUFFICIENT FUNDS
7 WITHIN THE ACCOUNT ON WHICH THE CHECK IS DRAWN. SUCH INSTITUTION MAY
8 REQUIRE, AS A CONDITION FOR CASHING SUCH CHECK, THAT THE PAYEE PRESENT A
9 VALID GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD.
10 2. IF A PERSON PRESENTS A FORM OF IDENTIFICATION, AS PROVIDED IN
11 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, AND A SIGNATURE OR MARK, AND THE INSTI-
12 TUTION REFUSES TO CASH THE CHECK IN THE ABSENCE OF CRIMINAL ACTIVITY,
13 SUCH INSTITUTION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
15 have become a law.
