AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to providing a program fee option for graduate students

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 10 to read as follows:
- (10) THE TRUSTEES SHALL ALSO ESTABLISH AN ACCESS FEE OPTION THAT WOULD ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS A CANDIDATE FOR A GRADUATE OR PROFESSIONAL DEGREE AND HAS COMPLETED AT LEAST THIRTY CREDITS, AND IS ON LEAVE FROM FULL-TIME STUDY, TO MAINTAIN ACCESS TO CERTAIN FACILITIES WITHIN THE
- 7 STATE UNIVERSITY SUCH AS LIBRARIES, COMPUTERS AND/OR STUDENT CENTERS IN
- 8 ORDER TO CONTINUE A RESEARCH PROJECT OR TO PURSUE OTHER ACADEMIC 9 REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE UNIVERSITY, WITHOUT BEING ENROLLED
- 10 IN REGULAR CREDIT COURSES. SUCH FEE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE COST OF ONE
- 10 IN REGULAR CREDIT COURSES. SUCH FEE SHALL NOT EXCEED THE COST OF ONE 11 CREDIT OF THE STUDENT'S PROGRAM OF GRADUATE OR DOCTORATE COURSE WORK AS
- 12 ESTABLISHED BY THE TRUSTEES OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY.
- 13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
