AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring the location of a proposed charter school to be included in the charter application

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (j) of subdivision 2 of section 2851 of the education law, as added by chapter 4 of the laws of 1998, is amended to read as follows:
- (j) Information regarding the facilities to be used by the school, including the location of the school, [if known,] and the means by which pupils will be transported to and from the school. [If the facilities to 7 be used by the proposed school are not known at the time the application 8 is submitted, the applicant shall notify the charter entity and, 9 applicable, the board of regents within ten business days of acquiring facilities for such school; provided, however, that the charter school 10 must obtain a certificate of occupancy for such facilities prior to the 11 12 date on which instruction is to commence at the school.]

S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it 13 14 have become a law and shall apply to any applications to establish a charter school submitted to a charter entity on or after such date. 15
