AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to distinctive license plates for Hispanic and African-American veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 404-x to read as follows:
- S 404-X. DISTINCTIVE PLATES FOR HISPANIC OR AFRICAN-AMERICAN VETERANS.

 1. ANY HISPANIC OR AFRICAN-AMERICAN VETERAN RESIDING IN THIS STATE

 SHALL, UPON REQUEST, BE ISSUED A LICENSE PLATE BEARING THE WORDS HISPAN
 IC OR AFRICAN-AMERICAN VETERAN, RESPECTIVELY. APPLICATION FOR SAID

 LICENSE PLATE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER IN SUCH FORM AND

 B DETAIL AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE.
- 9 2. THE DISTINCTIVE PLATE AUTHORIZED HEREIN SHALL BE ISSUED UPON PROOF, 10 SATISFACTORY TO THE COMMISSIONER, THAT THE APPLICANT IS AN HISPANIC OR 11 AFRICAN-AMERICAN VETERAN.
- 12 3. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED 13 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON PAYMENT OF THE REGULAR
- 14 REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE,
- 15 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NO SERVICE CHARGE SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH 16 PLATE.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
