AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in Wyoming county; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907
2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 11 of chapter
3 483 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:

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1 (i) The counties of Allegany, Cattaraugus, Chenango, Herkimer, Montgomery, Oneida, Oswego, Otsego, Schoharie [and], Tioga AND WYOMING and that portion of the county of Broome east of the Susquehanna river

Deer and bear, the first Monday after November 15 through first Tuesday after December 7

Pistol, shotgun, crossbow, muzzle loading firearm, rifle or long bow only

13 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately, provided that:

14 a. the amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 13 of chapter 600 of the laws of 1993, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect;

20 b. the amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law made by section two of this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such paragraph pursuant to section 17 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, as amended; and

25 c. nothing contained in this act shall be construed so as to extend the provisions of this act beyond January 1, 2014, when upon such date this act shall expire and the provisions contained in this act shall be deemed repealed.
