THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative findings. The legislature hereby finds and 1 2 declares that residential cooperative purchasers are subject to proc-3 esses and conditions that do not also apply to purchasers of other 4 single family residences. The legislature also finds that these processes and conditions, at a minimum, give the appearance and have the potential to be misused to illegally discriminate against a purchaser of 5 б 7 cooperative housing. Because this state strongly opposes all illeqal 8 discrimination and promotes fair housing laws and regulations, it is essential that the process for purchasing a cooperative dwelling include 9 10 additional safeguards to protect against illegal discrimination. This act is not intended and does not diminish the duty of cooperative boards 11 to uphold their established fiduciary duties. This act will significant-12 improve the transparency of the cooperative purchase process to the 13 lv benefit of all parties involved in the transaction. 14

15 S 2. The real property law is amended by adding a new article 11 to 16 read as follows: 17

SUCH NOTICE SHALL BE PROMULGATED 26 BY THE DIVISION OF HUMAN RIGHTS. 27 S 363. ACTION UPON APPLICATIONS. 1. WITHIN TEN DAYS OF RECEIPT OF Α 28 COMPLETED APPLICATION, THE COOPERATIVE SHALL PROVIDE THE APPLICANT WITH WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION AND, IF APPLICABLE, 29 WRITTEN NOTICE OF ANY WAY IN WHICH THE APPLICATION IS INCOMPLETE. AN 30 APPLICATION SHALL BE DEEMED COMPLETE UPON THE FAILURE OF A COOPERATIVE 31 32 TO TIMELY PROVIDE THE APPLICANT WITH SUCH NOTICE. 33 2. WITHIN FORTY-FIVE DAYS OF RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION, THE COOPER-34 ATIVE SHALL EITHER REJECT OR APPROVE THE APPLICATION AND PROVIDE THE 35 APPLICANT WITH WRITTEN NOTICE THEREOF. 3. WHENEVER ANY COOPERATIVE SHALL REJECT AN APPLICATION, SUCH COOPER-36 37 ATIVE SHALL PROVIDE THE APPLICANT WITH A WRITTEN STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR SUCH REJECTION. NO COOPERATIVE SHALL REJECT AN APPLICATION 38 BECAUSE OF THE RACE, CREED, COLOR, NATIONAL ORIGIN, SEXUAL ORIENTATION, 39 MILITARY STATUS, SEX, AGE, DISABILITY, MARITAL STATUS OR FAMILIAL STATUS 40 OF THE PURCHASER. 41 4.
