AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to allowing victims of domestic violence the opportunity to designate an alternate address for health insurance claims or billing purposes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2612 of the insurance law is amended by adding a 2 new subsection (h) to read as follows:

3 (H) NOTWITHSTANDING THE DEFINITIONS ESTABLISHED IN PARAGRAPHS TWO AND SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, EVERY INSURER, CORPORATION, 4 THREE OF 5 ORGANIZATION AND PROVIDER WHICH ISSUES A POLICY OR CONTRACT PURSUANT TO 6 ARTICLE THIRTY-TWO OR FORTY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER OR ARTICLE FORTY-FOUR 7 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW SHALL PROVIDE ANY INSURED, SUBSCRIBER OR 8 COVERED PERSON WHO IS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, UPON WRITTEN REQUEST OF SUCH INSURED, SUBSCRIBER OR COVERED PERSON, WITH THE OPTION 9 10 AN ALTERNATIVE MAILING ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER OR OTHER TΟ DESIGNATE 11 CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING SPECIFIC CLAIM INFORMA-12 TION OR FOR SPECIFIC BILLING PURPOSES RELATING SPECIFICALLY ΤO SUCH SUBSCRIBER OR COVERED PERSON. SUCH REQUESTED DESIGNATION SHALL 13 INSURED, 14 BE GRANTED UPON THE WRITTEN ATTESTATION OF THE INSURED, SUBSCRIBER OR COVERED PERSON THAT HE OR SHE IS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND THE 15 16 DISCLOSURE OF SUCH INFORMATION WOULD ENDANGER HIM OR HER. IF A CHILD IS COVERED PERSON, THE RIGHT ESTABLISHED BY THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE 17 THEASSERTED BY, AND SHALL EXTEND TO, THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF 18 THE CHILD. THE SUPERINTENDENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH, THE 19 20 OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AND THE OFFICE FOR THE PREVENTION 21 OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO GUIDE AND ENABLE SUCH 22 INSURERS, CORPORATIONS, ORGANIZATIONS AND PROVIDERS TO GUARD AGAINST THE

3 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-4 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to all 5 policies and contracts issued, renewed, altered or modified on or after 6 such effective date.
