AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to allowing victims of domestic violence the opportunity to designate an alternate address for health insurance claims or billing purposes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection (e) of section 2612 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 361 of the laws of 2006, is amended and a new subsection (h) is added to read as follows:

- (e) An insurer that complies with subsections (a), (f) [and], (q) AND (H) of this section and acts reasonably and in good faith shall not be subject to civil or criminal liability on account of compliance with such subsections.
- (H) NOTWITHSTANDING THE DEFINITIONS ESTABLISHED IN PARAGRAPHS TWO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, EVERY INSURER, CORPORATION, ORGANIZATION AND PROVIDER WHICH ISSUES A POLICY OR CONTRACT WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR HOSPITAL, SURGICAL OR MEDICAL COVERAGE, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE TYPE COVERAGE, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE THIRTY-TWO FORTY-THREE OF THIS CHAPTER OR ARTICLE FORTY-FOUR OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW, SHALL PROVIDE ANY INSURED, SUBSCRIBER OR COVERED PERSON WHO IS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, UPON WRITTEN REQUEST OF SUCH SUBSCRIBER OR COVERED PERSON, WITH THE OPTION TO DESIGNATE AN ALTERNA-TIVE MAILING ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER OR OTHER CONTACT INFORMATION FOR
