AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, the arts and cultural affairs law, the administrative code of the city of New York and the state finance law, in relation to stabilizing the cultural education account and the local government records management improvement fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of subdivision (a) and 2 subparagraph b of paragraph 11 of subdivision (b) of section 8021 of the 3 civil practice law and rules, subparagraph b of paragraph 4 of subdivi-4 sion (a) as amended by section 2 of part B of chapter 83 of the laws of 5 2002 and subparagraph b of paragraph 11 of subdivision (b) as amended by 6 section 3 of part B of chapter 83 of the laws of 2002, are amended to 7 read as follows:

8 b. For recording, entering, indexing and endorsing a certificate on any instrument, an additional fee of [five] SEVEN dollars AND FIFTY 9 10 CENTS to be paid monthly by county clerks to the commissioner of education, after deducting twenty-five cents, for deposit into the New York 11 state local government records management improvement fund and an addi-12 tional [fifteen] TWENTY-TWO dollars AND FIFTY CENTS, after deducting 13 [seventy-five cents] ONE DOLLAR, for deposit to the cultural education 14 15 account.

b. For recording any instrument required by statute to be recorded, an additional fee of [five] SEVEN dollars AND FIFTY CENTS to be paid monthly by county clerks to the commissioner of education, after deducting twenty-five cents, for deposit into the New York state local government records management improvement fund and an additional [fifteen] TWENTY-TWO dollars AND FIFTY CENTS, after deducting [seventy-five cents] ONE DOLLAR, for deposit to the cultural education account.

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1 S 2. Section 57.35 of the arts and cultural affairs law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 1-a to read as follows:

3 1-A. IN ADDITION TO THE GRANTS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE 4 OF THIS SECTION, IN EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCA-5 SUBJECT TO AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUCH PURPOSE, SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TION, 6 TO AWARD FORMULA GRANTS FOR RECORDS MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT PURSUANT TO 7 TO COUNTY CLERKS AND, IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK, TO THE THIS SUBDIVISION 8 NEW YORK REGISTER OR OTHER OFFICER OR AGENCY HAVING CUSTODY OF REAL RECORDS AND ANY OFFICER OR AGENCY HAVING CUSTODY OF SUPREME 9 PROPERTY 10 COURT RECORDS. THE AMOUNT OF EACH GRANT AWARD SHALL EQUAL THE PRODUCT OF 11 SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS AND THE NUMBER OF TRANSACTIONS ON WHICH A SURCHARGE 12 IMPOSED BY THE PUBLIC OFFICER OR AGENCY APPLYING FOR A GRANT IN THE WAS 13 PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR FOR DEPOSIT TO THE NEW YORK STATE LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPROVEMENT FUND PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH THREE OF 14 RECORDS MANAGEMENT 15 SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHTEEN, SUBPARAGRAPH В OF PARAGRAPH FOUR OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION EIGHT THOUSAND TWENTY-ONE 16 17 AND SUBPARAGRAPH B OF PARAGRAPH ELEVEN OF SUBDIVISION (B) OF SECTION 18 TWENTY-ONE OF THE CIVIL PRACTICE LAW AND RULES, AND EIGHT THOUSAND 19 SUBDIVISION A OF SECTION 7-604 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE CITY OF 20 NEW YORK.

21 S 3. Subdivision 3 of section 57.35 of the arts and cultural affairs 22 law, as added by chapter 78 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as 23 follows:

24 3. All monies received by the commissioner of education under the 25 provisions of [the third undesignated] paragraph THREE of subdivision 26 (a) of section eight thousand eighteen, subparagraph b of paragraph four 27 of subdivision (a) of section eight thousand twenty-one and subparagraph 28 b of paragraph eleven of subdivision (b) of section eight thousand twenty-one of the civil practice law and rules, and subdivision a of section 29 7-604 of the administrative code of the city of New York, shall be 30 deposited by the commissioner of education to the credit of the New York 31 32 state local government records management improvement fund established pursuant to section ninety-seven-i of the state finance law by the tenth 33 day of the month following receipt of such monies. 34

35 S 4. Subdivision a of section 7-604 of the administrative code of the 36 city of New York, as amended by section 4 of part B of chapter 83 of the 37 laws of 2002, is amended to read as follows:

38 The register shall be paid a salary to be fixed by the mayor. All a. 39 fees shall be the property of the city. All sums so received shall be 40 to the commissioner of finance monthly without deduction. The paid FOLLOWING additional [fee of twenty dollars] FEES 41 for recording any instrument required by New York state statute to be recorded pursuant to 42 43 subdivision one of section 7-614 of this code shall be [used as follows] [five] SEVEN dollars AND FIFTY CENTS paid monthly by the 44 COLLECTED: commissioner of finance to the New York state commissioner of education, after deducting twenty-five cents, for deposit into the New York state 45 46 47 local government records management improvement fund and [fifteen] TWEN-48 TY-TWO dollars AND FIFTY CENTS, after deducting [seventy-five cents] ONE 49 DOLLAR, for deposit to the cultural education account.

50 S 5. Subdivision 2 of section 97-zzz of the state finance law, as 51 added by section 3-a of part B of chapter 83 of the laws of 2002, is 52 amended to read as follows:

53 2. The comptroller is authorized and directed to receive for deposit 54 to the credit of the cultural education account revenues designated for 55 such deposit by law including those derived from the surcharge author-56 ized by [the third undesignated] paragraph THREE of subdivision (a) of

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section eight thousand eighteen of the civil practice and law and rules, subparagraph b of paragraph four of subdivision (a) of section eight thousand twenty-one of such law, subparagraph b of paragraph eleven of subdivision (b) of section eight thousand twenty-one of such law, [and] subdivision a of section 7-604[,] AND subdivision 1 of section 7-614 of the administrative code of the city of New York.

7 S 6. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 8 have become a law.
