AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to waiving civil service examination application fees for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 5 of section 50 of 2 the civil service law are relettered paragraphs (d) and (e) and a new 3 paragraph (c) is added to read as follows:
- NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVI-5 SION, THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL 6 COMMISSION SHALL WAIVE THE APPLICATION FEE OF ANY CANDIDATE WHO 7 APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTARY PROOF, TO THE CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT, A MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OR A REGIONAL COMMISSION THAT HE OR SHE IS A VETER-8 AN. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE 9 TERM "VETERAN" 10 OF ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO SERVED THEREIN IN $_{
 m THE}$ TIME OF WAR, WHO WAS HONORABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED 11 UNDER 12 CIRCUMSTANCES FROM SUCH SERVICE, WHO IS A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OR AN ALIEN LAWFULLY ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT 13 RESIDENCE IN THE STATES AND WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK AT THE TIME OF 14
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
