AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to remote metering by farm service and non-residential customer-generators

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 66-1 of the public service law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:
- 3 A FARM SERVICE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AS DEFINED BY PARAGRAPH (C) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION OR A NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER-GENERATOR 5 DEFINED PARAGRAPH (C-1) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION MAY BY LOCATE WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT WITH A NET ENERGY METER 7 LAND OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AND DESIGNATE ONE 8 HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE NET METERING CREDITS GENERATED BY SUCH EOUIPMENT 9 A METER OR METERS OWNED BY THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR AT ANY LOCATION 10 OWNED OR LEASED BY SUCH CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WITHIN THE SERVICE AREA OF THE SAME ELECTRIC CORPORATION TO WHICH THE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S NET 11 BEING WITHIN A ENERGY METERS ARE INTERCONNECTED AND 12 RADIUS OF TWENTY-FIVE MILES OF THE WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING EQUIPMENT. 13
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
