AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to  
prohibiting the sale of caffeinated or stimulant-enhanced alcoholic  
beverages

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 3 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended  
2     by adding a new subdivision 7-c to read as follows:  
3     7-C. "CAFFEINATED OR STIMULANT-ENHANCED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE" MEANS AND  
4     INCLUDES A BEER OR WINE PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN SIX PER CENTUM  
5     ALCOHOL BY VOLUME AND AN UNSAFE FOOD ADDITIVE. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS  
6     SUBDIVISION, "UNSAFE FOOD ADDITIVE" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS  
7     PROVIDED IN THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT (21 U.S.C. S 348)  
8     AND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, CAFFEINE OR OTHER STIMULANTS  
9     DIRECTLY ADDED TO AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE AS A SEPARATE INGREDIENT WITHOUT  
10    APPROVAL BY FEDERAL REGULATION OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AS GENERALLY RECOG-  
11    NIZED AS SAFE.  
12    S 2. Section 100 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by  
13    adding a new subdivision 8 to read as follows:  
14    8. NO LICENSEE, PERMITTEE OR PERSON SHALL SELL, DELIVER OR GIVE AWAY,  
15    OR CAUSE, PERMIT OR PROCURE TO BE SOLD, DELIVERED OR GIVEN AWAY ANY  
16    CAFFEINATED OR STIMULANT-ENHANCED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, AS DEFINED IN  
17    SUBDIVISION SEVEN-C OF SECTION THREE OF THIS CHAPTER.  
18    S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after  
19    it shall have become a law; provided that the provisions of this act  
20    shall not be deemed to prohibit any person, licensed to sell alcoholic  
21    beverages at retail for on-premises or off-premises consumption, from

1 selling, delivering or giving away any caffeinated or stimulant-enhanced  
2 alcoholic beverage to a distributor or manufacturer of such beverage  
3 within sixty days of the effective date of this act when the caffeinated  
4 or stimulant-enhanced beverage was received by the retail licensee prior  
5 to the effective date of this act. Effective immediately, the state  
6 liquor authority is authorized to amend, add and/or repeal any rules and  
7 regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act on or  
8 before its effective date.
