AN ACT to amend the limited liability company law and the general construction law, in relation to the definition of "newspaper"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 102 of the limited liability company law is amended by adding a new subdivision (ii) to read as follows:

3 (II) "NEWSPAPER" MEANS ANY NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WHICH IS
4 PRINTED AND DISTRIBUTED ON A DAILY OR WEEKLY BASIS AND HAS BEEN IN BUSI5 NESS FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING ANY PUBLICATION ADVER6 TISEMENT, AND WHICH CONTAINS NEWS, ARTICLES OF OPINION, FEATURES, ADVER7 TISING AND ANY OTHER MATTER REGARDED AS CURRENT INTEREST.

8 S 2. Subdivision a of section 60 of the general construction law, as 9 separately amended by chapters 724 and 725 of the laws of 1975, is 10 amended to read as follows:

In any case in which notice of any fact is required by law to be 11 a. 12 published or advertised in a newspaper, the term "newspaper" shall mean a paper of general circulation which is printed and distributed ordinar-13 ily not less frequently than once a week, and has been so for at least 14 15 one year immediately preceding such publication or advertisement, and which contains news, articles of opinion (as editorials), features, 16 17 advertising, or other matter regarded as of current interest, [has a 18 paid circulation] and (except for such a paper which has been printed and distributed not less frequently than once a week for a period of ten 19 years prior to January one, nineteen hundred seventy-five) has been 20 21 entered at United States post-office as second-class matter. A publica-22 tion which is distributed or made available primarily for advertising purposes to the public generally without consideration being paid there-23 for shall not be deemed to be a "newspaper" for the purpose of publica-24

tion or advertisement of such notice required by law. Notwithstanding any provision of this subdivision to the contrary, a publication which was designated and publishing notice as an official newspaper prior to the year nineteen hundred forty and continued to be so designated and publishing for at least thirty years after such year shall be deemed to be a newspaper within the meaning of this subdivision. S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
