AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to large capacity ammunition feeding devices

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 23 of section 265.00 of the penal law, as added by chapter 189 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:

- 23. "Large capacity ammunition feeding device" means a magazine, belt, drum, feed strip, or similar device[, manufactured after September thirteenth, nineteen hundred ninety-four], that has a capacity of, or that can be readily restored or converted to accept, more than ten rounds of ammunition; provided, however, that such term does not include an attached tubular device designed to accept, and capable of operating only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.
- 10 S 2. Subdivision 8 of section 265.02 of the penal law, as amended by 11 chapter 764 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (8) Such person possesses a large capacity ammunition feeding device.
 13 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION A LARGE CAPACI14 TY AMMUNITION FEEDING DEVICE SHALL NOT INCLUDE SUCH A DEVICE MANUFAC15 TURED PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER THIRTEENTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR
 16 POSSESSED BY ITS RIGHTFUL OWNER.
- 17 S 3. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-18 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
