AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to directing the city of Buffalo to adjudicate traffic infractions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 225 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law, as amended by chapter 173 of the laws of 1990, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of 1. (A) law, all violations of this chapter or of a law, ordinance, order, rule or regu-5 б lation relating to traffic, except parking, standing, stopping or pedes-7 trian offenses, which occur within a city having a population of two hundred thousand or more in which administrative tribunals have hereto-8 9 established, or within that portion of Suffolk county for fore been which a district court has been established, and which are classified as 10 11 traffic infractions, may be heard and determined pursuant to the requ-12 lations of the commissioner as provided in this article.

13 PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE WITH REGARD TO THE ADJUDICATION OF (B) FOR 14 ANY VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER OR OF A LAW, ORDINANCE, ORDER, RULE OR REGULATION RELATING TO TRAFFIC, WHICH IS CLASSIFIED AS A TRAFFIC INFRAC-15 TION, IN THE CITY OF BUFFALO, PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL 16 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF A GENERAL, 17 NOT APPLY. SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE CITY OF BUFFALO SHALL PROVIDE 18 BY LOCAL LAW FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION OF TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS. 19 20 (C) Whenever a crime and a traffic infraction arise out of the same 21 transaction or occurrence, a charge alleging both offenses may be made returnable before the court having jurisdiction over the crime. Nothing 22 23 herein provided shall be construed to prevent a court, having jurisdic-

1 tion over a criminal charge relating to traffic or a traffic infraction, 2 from lawfully entering a judgment of conviction, whether or not based on 3 a plea of guilty, for any offense classified as a traffic infraction. 4 S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2013. Effective immediate-5 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation 6 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are 7 authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such 8 effective date.
