AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to the purchase, sale, or installation of salvaged high-intensity discharge headlamps

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 398-e to read as follows:

- S 398-E. PURCHASE, SALE, OR INSTALLATION OF SALVAGED HIGH-INTENSITY DISCHARGE HEADLAMPS. 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A "HIGH-INTENSITY DISCHARGE/HID HEADLAMP" MEANS A HEADLAMP WHICH EMITS TWICE THE LIGHT OF A CONVENTIONAL HALOGEN HEADLAMP AND PRODUCES A BLUE-WHITE LIGHT.
- 7 8 PERSON ENGAGED IN BUSINESS OF PURCHASING, SELLING, OR ANY THE9 INSTALLING SALVAGED HIGH-INTENSITY DISCHARGE HEADLAMPS SHALL MAINTAIN A 10 MANUAL OR ELECTRONIC RECORD OF THE PURCHASE, SALE, OR INSTALLATION, WHICH MUST INCLUDE THE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF THE SALVAGED HID HEAD-11 VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF THE VEHICLE FROM WHICH THE 12 LAMP; THE ADDRESS, 13 SALVAGED HID HEADLAMP WAS REMOVED; THENAME, 14 LICENSE NUMBER OR OTHER MEANS OF IDENTIFICATION OF THE PERSON FROM WHOM 15 THE SALVAGED HID HEADLAMP WAS PURCHASED; AND, IN THE EVENT SALVAGED HID HEADLAMP IS INSTALLED, THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF 16 17 VEHICLE INTO WHICH THE HID HEADLAMP IS INSTALLED. SUCH RECORD MUST BE MAINTAINED FOR THIRTY-SIX MONTHS FOLLOWING THE TRANSACTION AND MAY BE 18 19 INSPECTED DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS BY ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF 20 THIS STATE. ANY PERSON WHO SELLS A SALVAGED HID HEADLAMP OR WHO INSTALLS A SALVAGED HID HEADLAMP MUST DISCLOSE TO THE PURCHASER OR CONSUMER 21 22 THE HID HEADLAMP IS SALVAGED.
- 3. ANY PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY POSSESSES, SELLS, OR INSTALLS A STOLEN UNINSTALLED HIGH-INTENSITY DISCHARGE HEADLAMP SHALL BE GUILTY OF A CLASS E FELONY. THE OWNER OR PROPRIETOR OF ANY BUSINESS THAT FAILS TO MAINTAIN
