AN ACT in relation to empowering the governor of the state of New York
to appoint either the New York state department of transportation or
the New York city department of transportation to take the leading
role in coordinating projects within New York city costing over twenty
million dollars

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Coordination of transportation projects. 1. Any project
2 within the city of New York costing more than twenty million dollars to
3 be undertaken by either the New York state department of transportation
4 or the New York city department of transportation shall be subject to
5 the provisions of this act.
6 2. No less than ninety days before the start of any such project, the
7 governor of the state of New York shall appoint either the New York
8 state department of transportation or the New York city department of
9 transportation to take the leading role in implementing such project.
10 3. The agency appointed by the governor shall coordinate monthly meet-
11 ings, to be held ninety, sixty and thirty days before the start of such
12 project, for coordinating the scheduling of such project and discussing
13 how to implement such project without any unnecessary or redundant work.
14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall
15 have become a law.
