- AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the disclosure of agency records; and to amend the education law, in relation to guidelines for foundations of state operated campuses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 86 of the public officers law, 1 as 2 added by chapter 933 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as follows: 3 3. (A) "Agency" means any state or municipal department, board, bureau, division, commission, committee, public authority, public corpo-4 5 ration, council, office or other governmental entity performing a 6 governmental or proprietary function for the state or any one or more 7 municipalities thereof, except the judiciary or the state legislature. 8 (B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, "AGENCY" SHALL INCLUDE THE RESEARCH 9 FOUNDATION OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK, FOUNDATIONS AND AUXILIA-SERVICE CORPORATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH ANY PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSI-10 RY TY, AND NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATIONS AND LIMITED LIABILITY 11 CORPORATIONS CREATED OR CONTROLLED BY ANY PUBLIC COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, AND THE 12 13 CORPORATIONS IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (D) OF SUBDIVISION FIVE OF SECTION STATE FINANCE LAW, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE 14 FIFTY-THREE-A OF THE 15 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE STATUTORY COLLEGES

3 S 2. Paragraph (1) of subdivision 2 of section 87 of the public offi-4 cers law, as added by section 12 of part II of chapter 59 of the laws of 5 2010, is amended and two new paragraphs (m) and (n) are added to read as 6 follows:

7 (1) are photographs, microphotographs, videotape or other recorded 8 images produced by a bus lane photo device prepared under authority of 9 section eleven hundred eleven-c of the vehicle and traffic law[.];

10 (M) ARE RECORDS OF AN AGENCY RELATING TO CHARITABLE DONORS OR PROSPEC-11 TIVE DONORS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FUND-RAISING STRATEGIES OF 12 AGENCIES IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION EIGHTY-SIX OF THIS ARTICLE, PROVIDED THAT RECORDS RELATING TO FUND-RAIS-13 14 ING STRATEGIES WOULD, IF DISCLOSED, IMPAIR THE ABILITY OF THOSE AGENCIES 15 ΤO ATTRACT OR GAIN DONATIONS, AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE NAME OF ANY 16 DONOR AND THE AMOUNT OF DONATION MADE BY SUCH DONOR SHALL BE SUBJECT TO 17 DISCLOSURE IF SUCH DONOR, OR ANY ENTITY IN WHICH SUCH DONOR HAS A 18 SUBSTANTIAL INTEREST, SEEKS TO TRANSACT BUSINESS, OR DOES TRANSACT BUSI-19 NESS, WITH THE AGENCY TO WHICH THE DONATION IS MADE WITHIN THREE YEARS 20 THE DATE OF SUCH DONATION. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL EXEMPT FROM OF 21 DISCLOSURE THE AMOUNT OR VALUE OF AN INDIVIDUAL GIFT, GRANT, DONATION OR 22 PLEDGE;

23 (N) ARE ACADEMIC OR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH OR RESEARCH-RELATED RECORDS, INCLUDING ANY DRAFT, PRELIMINARY OR UNFUNDED GRANT OR CONTRACT DOCUMENT, 24 25 SPONSORED BY THE AGENCY ITSELF OR IN CONJUNCTION WITH A THIRD WHETHER 26 PARTY, OR RECORDS RELATING TO THE AGENCY'S INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, WHICH, IF DISCLOSED, WOULD ADVERSELY AFFECT LICENSE, PATENT, COPYRIGHT OR OTHER 27 RIGHTS OF THE AGENCY. THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT PERMIT AN AGENCY TO WITH-28 29 HOLD RECORDS OR PORTIONS THEREOF PERTAINING TO THE NAME, TITLE, EXPENDI-TURE, SOURCE OR AMOUNT OF PUBLIC FUNDING RELATING TO SUCH RESEARCH OR 30 31 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.

32 S 3. The opening paragraph of subdivision 6 of section 355 of the 33 education law is designated paragraph (a) and a new paragraph (b) is 34 added to read as follows:

35 STATE UNIVERSITY TRUSTEES SHALL ADOPT GUIDELINES FOR FOUNDA-THE (B) TIONS OF STATE-OPERATED CAMPUSES THAT REQUIRE EACH FOUNDATION TO ADOPT A 36 37 CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY APPLICABLE TO SUCH FOUNDATION AND ITS AFFIL-IATED CORPORATIONS. AMONG OTHER ITEMS, THE STATE UNIVERSITY 38 TRUSTEES ' 39 GUIDELINES SHALL REQUIRE SUCH FOUNDATION POLICIES TO PROVIDE: (I) THAT 40 SERVICE AS A BOARD MEMBER OR OFFICER THEREOF SHALL NOT BE USED AS Α PRIVATE BENEFIT OR INUREMENT FOR THE BOARD MEMBER OR OFFICER 41 MEANS FOR OR RELATIVE THEREOF, OR ANY ENTITY IN WHICH THE BOARD MEMBER OR OFFICER, 42 OR RELATIVE THEREOF, HAS A BUSINESS INTEREST; (II) NO BOARD 43 MEMBER OR 44 OFFICER WHO IS A VENDOR OF GOODS OR SERVICES TO THE FOUNDATION OR ITS 45 AFFILIATED CORPORATION, OR HAS A BUSINESS INTEREST IN SUCH VENDOR, OR WHOSE RELATIVE HAS A BUSINESS INTEREST IN SUCH VENDOR, SHALL VOTE ON, OR 46 47 IN THE FOUNDATION'S ADMINISTRATION OF, AND TRANSACTION WITH PARTICIPATE 48 SUCH VENDOR; AND (III) A BOARD MEMBER OR OFFICER SHALL ADVISE THE CHAIR 49 OF THE FOUNDATION OR ITS AFFILIATED CORPORATION OF HIS, HER OR A RELA-50 TIVE'S BUSINESS INTEREST IN ANY SUCH EXISTING OR PROPOSED VENDOR WITH 51 FOUNDATION OR ITS AFFILIATE. THE STATE UNIVERSITY TRUSTEE'S GUIDE-THE LINES SHALL DEFINE THE NATURE OF A BUSINESS INTEREST AND THE 52 CLOSENESS A PERSONAL RELATION THAT BRING A RELATIONSHIP WITHIN THE PURPOSES OF 53 OF 54 THIS SECTION.

55 S 4. This act shall take effect January 1, 2012; provided, however, 56 that the amendments to paragraph (1) of subdivision 2 of section 87 of

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2 the repeal of such paragraph and shall expire and be deemed repealed 3 therewith; provided further that the amendments to subdivision 6 of 4 section 355 of the education law made by section three of this act shall 5 not affect the expiration of such subdivision and shall be deemed to 6 expire therewith.
