AN ACT in relation to the dissolution of the Oswego City Library and the redistribution of any funds and/or assets held by such library

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Oswego City Library and its incorporated trustees, created on April 15, 1854 is hereby dissolved and all assets, holdings, and belongings owned in whole or in part by the Oswego City Library shall be transferred to the Oswego School District Public Library, a public school district library granted an absolute charter in the first instance by the New York State Board of Regents on April 4, 2000.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
