AN ACT to authorize True North Tyler Street, LLC to file an application with the assessor of the city of Troy for a real property tax exemption

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
2     the assessor of the city of Troy is hereby authorized to accept from  
3     True North Tyler Street, LLC, a wholly owned and tax exempt subsidiary  
4     of Uncommon Schools, Inc., an application for exemption from real prop-  
5     erty taxes pursuant to section 408 of the real property tax law for the  
6     2010-2011 assessment roll for the parcels owned by True North Tyler  
7     Street, LLC, located in the city of Troy at 4 Tyler Street, otherwise  
8     known as tax map parcel number 111.52-6-1. If accepted, the application  
9     shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable  
10    status date established for such roll.

11    If satisfied that True North Tyler Street, LLC would otherwise be  
12    entitled to such exemption if it had filed the application for exemption  
13    by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor of the city of Troy  
14    may, upon approval by the city council of such city, grant exemption  
15    with respect to the 2010-2011 assessment roll and owing by such not-for-  
16    profit organization on the effective date of this act and make appropri-  
17    ate corrections to the subject roll, the governing body or tax depart-  
18    ment may, in its sole discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes  
19    paid and cancel taxes, fines, penalties or interest remaining unpaid.

20    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
