AN ACT relating to permitting the continued use of certain outdoor advertising signs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 88 of the highway  
2     law, or any regulations adopted pursuant to such law, an outdoor advertising sign shall be allowed to continue to exist if such sign: (i) was  
3     lawfully in existence prior to September 1, 1965; (ii) is located in  
4     Montgomery county and is visible from the New York State Thruway; and  
5     (iii) was damaged by bad weather and rebuilt prior to January 1, 2007.  
6     S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
