AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to notification that all physician information on the department of health's website may not be all-inclusive or up-to-date

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 15 of section 2995-a of the public health law, 2 as added by chapter 542 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 15. (A) All physician data disseminated shall include the following 5 [statement] STATEMENTS: "THE DATA COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT IS ACCU-RATE TO THE BEST OF THE KNOWLEDGE OF THE DEPARTMENT, BASED ON THE INFOR-6 7 MATION SUPPLIED BY THE PHYSICIAN WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DATA. WHILE DEPARTMENT UTILIZES A VARIETY OF SOURCES OF INFORMATION IN CHECKING 8 THE THE ACCURACY OF THE DATA REPORTED, WE CANNOT BE SURE THAT 9 ALL OF THE 10 INFORMATION ON THIS WEBSITE IS RIGHT, COMPLETE, OR UP-TO-DATE, AND CANNOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INFORMATION THAT IS WRONG OR HAS BEEN LEFT 11 ТО 12 OUT. CONSUMERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CONSULT OTHER SOURCES VERIFY OR INFORMATION ABOUT A PHYSICIAN, 13 OBTAIN ADDITIONAL INCLUDING ACTIONS AGAINST A PHYSICIAN." THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ENSURE THAT THE 14 FULLTEXT 15 OF THE STATEMENTS APPEAR ON EACH WEB PAGE OF THE PHYSICIAN PROFILE IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT REQUIRE THE USER OF THE SITE TO CLICK ON A SEPARATE 16 17 LINK IN ORDER TO VIEW THE STATEMENTS.

18 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE ON THE PHYSICIAN PROFILES AN ACTIVE 19 LINK TO THE WEBSITE MAINTAINED BY THE UNIFIED COURT SYSTEM CONTAINING 20 INFORMATION ON ACTIVE AND DISPOSED CASES IN THE LOCAL AND STATE COURTS 21 IN THE STATE.

22 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 23 have become a law.
