AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to requiring the power authority of the state of New York produce a report detailing best practices with regard to energy cost savings for schools; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 17 of section 1005 of the
2 public authorities law, as added by chapter 477 of the laws of 2009 and
3 such subdivision as renumbered by section 16 of part CC of chapter 60 of
4 the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:
5 (f) The authority shall complete and submit a report, on or before
6 [January thirty-first, two thousand twelve, on those activities under-
7 taken pursuant to this subdivision to the governor, the speaker of the
8 assembly, the temporary president of the senate, the minority leader of
9 the senate, the minority leader of the assembly, the chair of the senate
10 finance committee, the chair of the assembly ways and means committee,
11 the chair of the assembly energy committee and the chair of the senate

10 THE PROVISION OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY SERVICES, CLEAN ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES
11 TO PUBLIC AND NONPUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE
12 STATE, ESTIMATED IMPACTS ON EMPLOYMENT, ENERGY COST SAVINGS, GREENHOUSE
13 GAS REDUCTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW TO INCORPORATE PARTICIPATION
14 IN THE PROGRAM INTO SCIENCE, MATH AND TECHNOLOGY CURRICULUM.
15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be
16 deemed repealed July 31, 2013.
