AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to the posting of certain signs

- 1 Section 1. Section 19.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision (i) to read as follows:
- (I) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE POSTING OF SIGNS ADVISING WHERE TO GET HELP REGARDING THE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT OF A NARCOTICS ADDICTION, IN ALL FACILITIES LICENSED BYTHESTATE TO DISPENSE PRESCRIPTION DRUGS TO THE PUBLIC. SUCH SIGNS, NOT MORE THAN THREE INCHES 7 INCHES, MUST BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED BY THE FACILITY AT EACH COUNTER OR OTHER LOCATION WHERE PRESCRIPTIONS ARE DISPENSED. THE MATION CONTAINED IN SUCH SIGNAGE SHALL ALSO BE POSTED ON THE INTERNET AT 9 APPROPRIATE INTERNET SITES.

 11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
