AN ACT to amend the economic development law, the public authorities law and the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to providing a preference to small businesses and entrepreneurs in the award of state economic development assistance

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The economic development law is amended by adding a new 2 section 101-a to read as follows:
- 3 101-A. PREFERENCES TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. IN EACH PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AND CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH 5 6 PROGRAM, PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS 7 BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING OF THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY TO SMALL BUSI-8 NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSI-9 10 NESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN ACCESSING AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING AND WORKING TO MEET THE GOAL OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT 11 12 AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRE-NEURS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "ENTREPRENEUR" SHALL 13 PERSON WHO ORGANIZES, OPERATES, AND ASSUMES THE RISK OF A START-UP 14 15 BUSINESS VENTURE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE INTHEANNUAL REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION THIRTY-SEVEN-A OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED 16 17 OF THIS ARTICLE A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS RECEIVING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY 18 WHETHER THE TWENTY PERCENT GOAL WAS MET FOR EACH PROGRAM. 19
- 20 S 2. Section 1823 of the public authorities law is amended by adding a 21 new subdivision 8 to read as follows:
- 22 8. IN EACH PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE AUTHORITY, AND 23 CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH PROGRAM, PREFERENCE SHALL BE

GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF SUCH FUNDS TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING 3 OF THE PROGRAM SPECIFICALLY TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN 5 ACCESSING AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING AND WORK-6 ING TO MEET THE GOAL OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT OF AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER 7 THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. THE AUTHORITY SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL PROGRAM REPORT 12 REOUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION EIGHTEEN HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE-A OF THIS 13 14 TITLE A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS PROVIDED WITH 15 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY WHETHER THE TWENTY PERCENT GOAL WAS MET FOR EACH PROGRAM. 16 17

- S 3. Section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968 constituting the New York state urban development corporation act is amended by adding a new section 4-a to read as follows:
- 20 S 4-A. IN EACH PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE CORPORATION 21 PURSUANT TO AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS, AND CONSISTENT WITH ANY STATUTE GOVERNING SUCH PROGRAM, PREFERENCE SHALL BE GIVEN TO THE AWARD OF 23 FUNDS TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. SUCH PREFERENCE SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ACTIVE MARKETING OF THE PROGRAM SPECIF-24 25 ICALLY TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO 26 INDIVIDUAL SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS IN ACCESSING AVAILABLE 27 FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM, AND ESTABLISHING AND WORKING TO MEET THE GOAL 28 OF AWARDING TWENTY PERCENT OF AVAILABLE FUNDS UNDER THE PROGRAM TO SMALL BUSINESSES AND ENTREPRENEURS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE 29 "SMALL BUSINESS" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 131 30 OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT LAW AND THE TERM "ENTREPRENEUR" SHALL MEAN A 31 PERSON OR PERSONS WHO ORGANIZES, OPERATES, AND ASSUMES THE RISK OF A 32 START-UP BUSINESS VENTURE. THE CORPORATION SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL 33 34 PROGRAM REPORT REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY OF THIS ACT A DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES, A LISTING OF PROPOSALS PROVIDED WITH FINAN-35 CIAL ASSISTANCE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND IDENTIFY WHETHER THE TWENTY 36 37 PERCENT GOAL WAS MET FOR EACH PROGRAM.
