AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing special access to hunting and fishing grounds on state land for handicapped individuals

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 11-0115 to read as follows:

S 11-0115. HANDICAPPED ACCESS FOR HUNTING AND FISHING GROUNDS ON STATE LAND.

THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS AUTHORIZING SPECIAL ACCESS TO HUNTING AND FISHING GROUNDS ON STATE LANDS FOR WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED HANDICAPPED PARKING PERMITS PURSUANT TO SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED THREE-A OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW. SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO ALLOWING RULES AND ACCESS TO CERTAIN DESIGNATED HUNTING AND FISHING GROUNDS ON STATE
