AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of  
concealment of a death

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,  
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Amanda Lynn's  
2     Law".  
3     S 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 190.18 to read  
4     as follows:  
5     S 190.18 CONCEALMENT OF A DEATH.  
6     A PERSON IS GUILTY OF CONCEALMENT OF A DEATH WHEN HE OR SHE KNOWINGLY  
7     MOVES OR OTHERWISE CONCEALS A HUMAN CORPSE SO THAT DISCOVERY OF THE  
8     DEATH OF SUCH PERSON WILL BE HINDERED.  
9     CONCEALMENT OF A DEATH IS A CLASS D FELONY.  
10    S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after  
11    it shall have become a law.
