AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring warning labels on fireplaces and fireplace enclosures that have glass viewing panels

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 378 of the executive law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 17 to read as follows:

17. STANDARDS FOR FACTORY MANUFACTURED FIREPLACES AND FIREPLACE ENCLO-SURES WHICH HAVE GLASS VIEWING PANELS REQUIRING THAT EVERY SUCH FIRE-PLACE AND ENCLOSURE, SOLD OR INSTALLED AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF 5 SUBDIVISION, SHALL HAVE AFFIXED TO THE GLASS PANELS THEREOF, A CONSPICU-WARNING LABEL ADVISING THE CONSUMER OF THE GRAVE RISK OF 8 SERIOUS BURNS POSED BY TOUCHING SUCH GLASS PANELS WHEN Α FIREPLACE 9 SUCH WARNING LABEL SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE GLASS OF A OPERATING. NO 10 FIREPLACE OR FIREPLACE ENCLOSURE BY ANY PERSON; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, SUCH A FIREPLACE OR FIREPLACE ENCLOSURE IS INSTALLED IN AN OWNER 11 OCCUPIED DWELLING, SUCH WARNING MAY BE REMOVED BY THE OWNER WHO OCCUPIES 12 13 SUCH DWELLING. ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED PURSU-THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE LIABLE FOR A CIVIL PENALTY NOT TO 14 15 EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, that any
18 rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this act
19 on its effective date are authorized and directed to be promulgated,
20 amended and/or repealed on or before such date.
