- AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to defining the terms "retiree" and "beneficiary" within the freedom of information law

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 86 of the public officers law is amended by adding 2 two new subdivisions 6 and 7 to read as follows:

3 6. "RETIREE" MEANS A FORMER OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF AN AGENCY, THE 4 STATE LEGISLATURE, OR THE JUDICIARY WHO IS ALSO A MEMBER OF A PUBLIC 5 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

7. "BENEFICIARY" MEANS A PERSON CHOSEN BY A RETIREE TO RECEIVE PENSION7 BENEFITS FOLLOWING THE DEATH OF THE RETIREE.

8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
