AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing the hunting of big game in the county of Albany with pistols, rifles, shotguns, crossbows and long bows

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Items (d) and (e) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of 2 section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by 3 section 11 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, are amended to read as 4 follows: 5 (d) Eastern region, Deer, first Monday Pistol, shotgun, 6 except ALBANY, after November 15 crossbow, 7 Columbia, Fulton, through first Tuesday muzzle loading firearm 8 Orange, Rensselaer, after December 7 or long bow only 9 Saratoga, Washington 10 Counties and those 11 counties or portions 12 thereof listed in 13 item (i) of this 14 paragraph	15 (e) Fulton, Saratoga, Deer, first Monday Pistol, rifle, 16 Washington (parts after November 15 shotgun, 17 in the Southern through first Tuesday crossbow 18 zone), ALBANY, after December 7 or long bow 19 Columbia, Orange, 20 and Rensselaer 21 counties

49 this act shall be subject to the expiration and reversion of such para-
50 graph pursuant to section 17 of chapter 483 of the laws of 2010, as
51 amended, when upon such date the provisions of section three of this act
