AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring a three day aging period before all city board votes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 8 of section 2590-g of the education law is amended by adding a new paragraph (d) to read as follows:

- (D) PRIOR TO THE APPROVAL OF ANY PROPOSED ITEM LISTED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, COPIES OF THE ACTUAL PROPOSED ITEMS UNDER CONSIDERATION AND NOT JUST SUMMARIES MUST BE GIVEN TO ALL CITY BOARD MEMBERS AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC, INCLUDING VIA THE CITY BOARD'S OFFICIAL INTERNET WEBSITE, AT LEAST THREE FULL DAYS BEFORE THE BOARD MAY VOTE.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law; provided, however, that the amendments to subdivision 11 8 of section 2590-g of the education law made by section one of this act 12 shall not affect the expiration of such section and shall be deemed to 13 expire therewith.
