AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the eligibility of certain family members of homicide victims

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 624 of the executive law, as amended by chapter 427 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) a surviving spouse, grandparent, parent, stepparent, GUARDIAN, 5 BROTHER, SISTER, STEPBROTHER, STEPSISTER, child or stepchild of a victim 6 of a crime who died as a direct result of such crime;
 - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
