AN ACT to amend the public authorities law and the executive law, in relation to database and reporting requirements for contracts with minority and women-owned businesses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new
2 section 2807 to read as follows:
3 S 2807. DATABASE AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTS WITH MINORI-
4 TY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES. EVERY STATE AUTHORITY CONTINUED OR
5 CREATED BY THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER CHAPTER OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF
6 NEW YORK SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN A DATABASE TO TRACK THE ISSUANCE OF
7 CONTRACTS TO MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED ENTERPRISES. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS
8 SECTION, A MINORITY OR WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE SHALL BE DEFINED
9 AS IN SUBDIVISION FOURTEEN OF SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX-C OF THIS
10 CHAPTER. EVERY STATE AUTHORITY CONTINUED OR CREATED BY THIS CHAPTER OR
11 ANY OTHER CHAPTER OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK SHALL COMPILE
12 REPORTS ON THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH CONTRACTS AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF
13 CONTRACTS AWARDED. SUCH REPORTS SHALL BE FILED ON A YEARLY BASIS WITH
14 THE AUTHORITIES, BUDGET OFFICE, DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
15 OFFICE OF MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES AND BE DISPLAYED ON THE
16 PUBLIC AUTHORITIES OR PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION'S WEBSITE AND THE
17 WEBSITE OF THE AUTHORITIES' BUDGET OFFICE, PROVIDED, HOWEVER THAT ALL
18 PROPRIETARY INFORMATION SHALL BE KEPT OFFLINE.
19 S 2. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 315-a to

21 S 315-A. DATABASE AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTS WITH MINOR-
22 ITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES. ALL STATE AGENCIES SHALL CREATE AND

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1 MAINTAIN A DATABASE TO TRACK THE ISSUANCE OF CONTRACTS TO MINORITY AND
2 WOMEN-OWNED ENTERPRISES. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A MINORITY OR
3 WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE SHALL BE DEFINED AS IN SUBDIVISION FOUR-
4 TEEN OF SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX-C OF THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES
5 LAW. STATE AGENCIES SHALL COMPILE REPORTS ON THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH
6 CONTRACTS AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CONTRACTS AWARDED. SUCH REPORTS SHALL
7 BE FILED ON A YEARLY BASIS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
8 OFFICE OF MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES AND BE DISPLAYED ON THE
9 STATE AGENCIES' WEBSITE, PROVIDED HOWEVER, ALL PROPRIETARY INFORMATION
10 SHALL BE KEPT OFFLINE.

11 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
12 have become a law; provided, however, that the amendment made to article
13 15-A of the executive law by section two of this act shall not affect
14 the repeal of such article and shall be deemed repealed therewith.
